Types of work: Bridge Replacement

Length/Location: On CSAH 15 – 5.0 Miles North of US-TH 12

Combined Major Items:

- Remove Existing (4-lines) RCP Pipe Culvert (72")
- Install 2 lines 12' x 6' RC Box (with end sections)
- Random RipRap – Class III (quarry rock) - 200 Ton
- Aggregate Base Class 5 - 550 Ton
- Type SP 12.5 Bituminous Wearing Course Mixture (2,B) - 146 Ton

Bids must be accompanied by a certified check made payable to the Treasurer of Swift County, or a corporate surety bond made in favor of Swift County equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. The County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any defects.
