Septic System owner guides were sent along with the permit for each system installed. Attended SSTS continuing education. Met with state MPCA staff on Talking Tour for septic systems. Also have discussed the possibility of holding a soils class in Swift County that would include surrounding counties. We feel this could help our designers/installers to better understand soils within our region. Visited with state employees about the need for potential education for newly licensed installers. Submitted the 2017 SSTS annual report.</p>
